

PINNACLE POINT OPEN TO PUBLIC

Pinnacle Point Beach & Golf Resort recently celebrated the third anniversary of its launch by opening the golf course to the public, as from December 1. Previously, only members, home-owners and residents could play the spectacular Peter Matkovich design.

Wayne Krambeck, the director responsible for golf at the Pinnacle Point Group, said the new policy was part of a strategy to broaden access to the golf facilities of the resort, but on a limited basis. "Pinnacle Point can accommodate more golfers, who would appreciate the magnificence of the course and our unique facilities," he said. "The new open door policy also helps the profitability of the resort, but we will not let it prejudice our existing members in any way."

Pinnacle Point will still retain exclusivity, as the visitor green fee is R795 a round, which includes a golf cart.
